Abstracts of registered participants are invited for consideration of contributory poster presentations. Submissions can be sent by e-mail as a doc file to: rm8509@rediffmail.com

Format for Abstract

Font: Times New Roman Black

Title of abstract (14 point bold, centered)

Name of author(s), underline the presenting author, (12 point normal, centered)

Department name, institute name and address (12 point normal, centered)

E-mail id of the corresponding author (11 point normal, centered)

Body text (12 point normal, justify)

Abstract length should not exceed 250 words (excluding title, authors and affiliation)

Abstract should not include any tables, images or references.

Schemes (if any) should be between the paragraphs with center alignment. All accepted abstracts will be included in the abstract CD only on payment of registration fee.

Acceptance of the abstract will be communicated to the corresponding author by 10th Nov. 2009 through email.

Poster size should be one meter by one meter, with readable font size and type.

An award and a certificate will be given to young scientist up to the age of 35 years for poster presentations. Those interested in participating in this contest must inform in advance and send the proof of age along with the abstract.
